## **SARA Documentation**

**Scanning** (state problem): 2911 Lincoln Place is a single-family building that is unoccupied and is being used by squatters and for drug activity. A complaint about this building came to District Four from the property owner of 2915 Lincoln Place. The complainant stated that the abandoned building is building used for criminal activity such as prostitution and drug usage.

**Analysis** (identify factual support): Residents who lived in the area reported finding used condoms and drug paraphernalia in the area.

**Response** (define action taken): Police Officer LaDon Laney requested an emergency board-up of the premises. A form 305 was completed for Beat 2 officers, requesting extra attention during their shifts. During 2005 there were four arrest made in the area of this building. March 2005- Domestic, Violence, July 2005- Receiving stolen property (motorcycle), and Open Flask, October 2005- marijuana possession,
