Description of Problem: Drug abuse and prostitution complaints.

## **SARA Documentation**

Scanning (state problem): Groups of individuals congregate on the corner of McMicken Street and Findlay Avenue around dark and unlit areas. These individuals appear responsible for the majority of the crime and disorder at this intersection. Reports of drug dealing, drug usage and prostitution are frequent. These conditions create the appearance of neighborhood decline and have instilled fear among those living there.

Analysis (identify factual support): I responded to the location to conduct a preliminary investigation into this complaint. I confirmed the validity of the allegation and located several individuals standing in the area where it was dark.

Response (define action taken): At the current point an form 318 has been completed requesting public works to look into the matter of addressing the lights that have burnt and/or been knocked out. More patrol units have been addressed to patrol this intersection.

Assessment (document measurement): This is an on-going project that officers will continue to monitor. The radio runs and arrest summaries have decreased. The lights have been fixed.
