Scanning (state problem):

Groups of individuals congregate on the dark corner of McMicken Street and Findlay Avenue around the dark and unlit areas. These individuals appear responsible for the majority of the crime and disorder at this intersection. These conditions create the appearance of neighborhood decline and have instilled fear among those living there. The problem occurs at the intersection of Findlay Avenue and West McMicken Avenue.

Analysis (identify factual support):

Beat officers provided a concentrated effort from June 2006 thru August 31, 2006. they determined that a higher concentration of individuals were congregating at this intersection which was in an dark/unlit corner.

Response (define action taken):

Public works responded on August 12, 2006 and corrected the lightening situation. The will continue to monitor the area to ensure it is well lit. This illuminated the area and discourages individuals from loitering and committing criminal activities. Since the lightening was corrected an over decrease of individual were present at the corner. Officers, on a daily basic officer have been monitoring the area.

Assessment (document measurement):

This is an on-going project that officers will continue to monitor. The amount of pedestrian traffic and loitering in the area has decreased. The lights have been fixed.
