Scanning (state problem):

Analysis (identify factual support):

Time frame being analyzed is January 1, 2006 thru October 1, 2006. The reports requested are thefts from autos and property damage reports.

Response (define action taken): Officer has set up signal 33 for the areas. No parking and no trespassing signs were posted. Directed patrols are on going.
