## **SARA Documentation**

Scanning (state problem): Buses and cars blocking driveways and vehicle traffic

Analysis (identify factual support): The citizen's complaints are received from a home owner in the area of TCP Academy.

Response (define action taken): CPOP team met with the principal of TCP Academy and came up with a plan to resolve the problem. The solution was to allow only two to three buses at the school at one time. The other buses would stage at a nearby parking lot and respond to the school after one of the other buses departed.

Assessment (document measurement): Since the plan has been implemented there have been no more complaints about parking or buses blocking traffic.
