Scanning (state problem): complaints have been received from the community and community council regarding the parking of vehicles on the sidewalk and in violation of signs in the 3700 block of Beekman Street. This results in pedestrians forced to walk in the street. When confronted some of the vehicle owners have threatened the pedestrians

Analysis (identify factual support): the store and car wash as well as street vendors seem to be the main reason for the parking violations.

Response (define action taken): Directed patrols have been put in place to cite vehicles found in violation. The community council has been asked to forward any complaints of parking in the area directly to police for immediate response.
