Description of Problem: There had been numerous calls for service regarding drugs, shots fired, disorderly conduct, and prositution.

Phase of SARA: Response

## **SARA Documentation**

Scanning (state problem): Groups of individuals congregate in the court yard of 1722 W. Northbend Road. Disorderly individuals and occassional shots fired are a complaint of nearby residents. These conditions create the appearance of neighborhood decline and have instilled fear among those living around the area.

Analysis (identify factual support): Families residing at 1722 W. Northbend Road are constantly getting into physical altercations, they then call other family members and friends in on the situation. Drug sales are taking place in the parking lot of the complex. An unknown female black is approaching vehicles and solicting. Between the time frame of 2100 and 2300 hours, shots fired are being heard.

Between March and June there have been 8 disorderly calls, 11 family trouble calls, and 1 shots fired call. There have been a total of 51 calls for service to this area since March.

Response (define action taken): Directed patrols were done in this area by all shifts, both in marked police cars and on foot patrol.

Assessment (document measurement): There is a request for the numbers of calls for service to assess the response.
